Brief description of facility/site: Camp Olave is a 118 acre site, fenced on 3 sides and water on the 4th. It has many sites including platform tents, huts, bunk houses and tenting pads. It is an established Girl Guide camp site on the ocean with small cabins & platform tents, fully equipped Outdoor Kitchens, hiking trails, archery, low ropes. Life guards are on site.

Girls will travel in a patrol of 6 or less, 2 patrols will be together at all times. When girls are on site they will be monitored by the site manager and the patrol leaders. Girls are not allowed to leave the site without a Guiders permission or with a guider

**Arrangements for transportation (if applicable):**
